1. Lee Marshall is a canoeist and kayaker who tested positive for testosterone on 16 February 2019.
2. On 5 July 2019, DFSNZ filed an Application for the Provisional Suspension of Mr Marshall. DFSNZ confirmed service on Mr Marshall that same day.
3. A telephone conference was convened by the Tribunal Chairman on 18 July 2019 in respect of the Provisional Suspension Application. Mr Marshall advised that he did not oppose the application.
4. Accordingly, and being satisfied that there was no substantive reason why provisional suspension should not be imposed, the Tribunal Chairman ordered the provisional suspension of Mr Marshall with immediate effect from 18 July 2019. Mr Marshall may not take part in any way in any event or activity, organised, sanctioned or authorised by any sporting organisation which is a signatory to the SADR.
5. The following timetabling orders were made in relation to the substantive anti-doping rule violation proceedings:
  - (a) DFSNZ is to file and serve its Form 1 and any written material in support by Thursday 1 August 2019;
  - (b) the Respondent is to file and serve his Form 2 together with any evidence and other written material in support by Thursday 15 August 2019; and
  - (c) A further teleconference is set for 9.20am Friday 16 August 2019.
6. A copy of this Provisional Suspension Order and Minute will be sent to the parties but otherwise should remain confidential until publication of the final decision on the Anti-Doping Rule Violations. All other process steps under the SADR should similarly remain confidential.
